## IRB Module Highlights

- Replacing IRBNet
- Data Migration:
  - Expect “downtime” in mid-May while data is migrated and tested
  - Migrated data: Study Title, Approval/Expiration Dates, PI, Student Investigator, Department, Funding, currently approved Protocol (.doc), IRBNet ref #
- IRBNet will remain available to access documents for one year
- Encourage PIs to download all of their IRB documentation before May 2023 (minimum 3 year retention)

- Go Live currently scheduled for May 17, 2022
